The meeting was called to order at the appointed time by Mayor Gary Damron. Those in attendance were Darryl Chittenden, Brandon Deboe and Donnie Willbanks.

Brandon led the Pledge to the American Flag.

Treasurer's Report

Reading of Minutes: Brandon made a motion; 2nd by Darryl to accept minutes from last month's meeting. Motion carried.

Pay Bills: Darryl made a motion; 2nd by Brandon to pay the bills. Motion carried.

Website: The Website is up and active. There are still items to be added along with web pay, which is being worked on presently. The CARES Funding reimbursed the \$13,000.00 set-up cost.

Noise Pollution Ordinance #22-01: Brandon made a motion; 2nd by Darryl to accept the first reading of the Ordinance #22-01 related to the prohibition of loud and unreasonable noise within the corporate city limits of Salem, KY, with the minor change of fines adding \$50 to each fine when served by the Sheriff's office. Motion carried.

Deer Lakes Clubhouse Flag: The City will be donating an American Flag to the clubhouse.

Plant Superintendent

Sampler – Darryl made a motion; 2nd by Brandon to purchase a new controller for the sampler for \$2,400; as well as lease a machine for \$300 until the new controller becomes available, which could take up to 6 weeks. Motion carried.

Water License – Darit's test has been postponed until February 10th, due to Covid.

Water Loss – December water loss was 31%.

Tires – Darryl made a motion; 2nd by Brandon to purchase new tires for the F-150 pick-up truck from Hunter's Auto for \$576. Motion carried.

Manhole – The manhole at the Family Dollar / Dollar Tree new build will need to be lowered at a cost of \$4,300. The cost will be paid by the builders.

Mayor's Reports


