

**COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY
CITY OF SALEM, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 21-07**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM §50.135
SEWAGE SERVICE RATES**

WHEREAS the City of Salem, Kentucky provides sewer services to its citizens and the cost of providing those services has increased, and

WHEREAS the City of Salem, Kentucky has audited its income and expenses for its sewer department and finds that to continue to properly provide for the sewer services currently and to allow for maintenance in the future it is necessary to increase the sewer rates to its customers and promote the general health, safety and welfare of its citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF SALEM, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. § 53.135 Sewage Service Rates is amended as follows:

(A) [...] The minimum charge for larger water service connections are as follows:

Connection	Base Rate	
	Old Rate \$	New Rate \$
5/8" to 3/4"	12.00	13.00
1"	24.00	25.90
1 1/2"	48.02	51.86
2"	84.04	96.76

(B) The treatment fee shall be ~~\$8.00~~ \$9.00 per 1,000 gallons as metered.

SECTION 2: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision.

SECTION 3: All portions of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.


